VAN

<u>V</u> isual Disturbance	Field cut, double vision, or blindness
<u>A</u> phasia	Inability to speak or understand (do not count slurred speech)
<u>N</u> eglect	Inability to detect bilateral simultaneous stimulation or lack of awareness or extinction of half of the body

FAST-ED Scale

Normal or minor paralysis	0
Partial or complete paralysis	1
Arm weakness	
No drift	0
Drift or some effort against gravity	1
No effort against gravity or no movement	2
Speech changes	
Absent	0
Mild to moderate	1
Severe, global aphasia or mute	2
Eye deviation	
Absent	0
Partial	1
Forced deviation	2
Denial / Neglect	
Absent	0
Extinction to bilateral simultaneous stimulation in only one sensory modality	1
Does not recognize own hand or orients only to one side of the body	2
